The historic and scenic Hudson River travels 315 miles from the Adirondack Mountains to the Atlantic Ocean. The river was discovered in 1609 by Dutch explorer Henry Hudson and his crew aboard the "Half Moon" while they searched for a route to the Pacific. The Hudson has inspired artists, poets, and writers. Its scenic beauty has often caused people to compare it to the Rhine River in Germany, and millions of visitors from around the world visit the region every year.

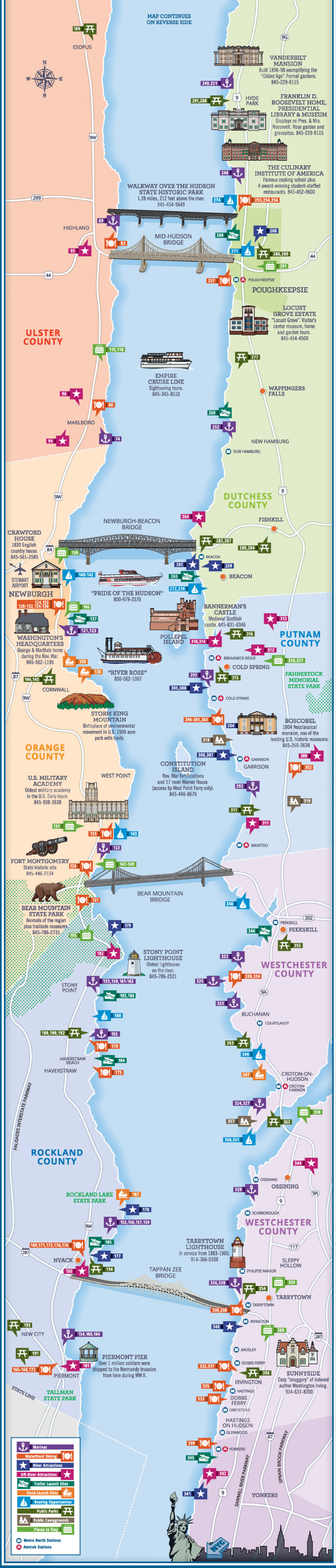
